\* Thanks to Earles Signs, the main sign at the Terrace Garden is now complete. The Terrace Garden is a Blyth Progress Association project with support from the Wakefield Regional Council. Most of the plants in The Terrace Garden have been chosen for their ability to withstand dry periods or to be able to adapt to alkaline soils (the soil here is deep clay with a pH 8-8.5). Around 700 species are represented with some 230 named, in particular local species.

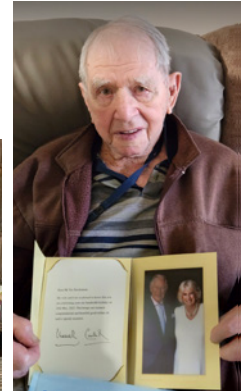

*Vic Stockmann celebrating his 100th birthday with family*



\* Congratulations to Vic Stockmann who turned a 100 on the 26th May. Vic was born in the Blyth Hospital and his parents were farming West of Hoyleton. In 1927 the family bought 400 acres from Hughes Park and this property near the foothills, west of Kybunga, became the family farm. Vic attended Kybunga Primary School to grade 7 and then went rabbiting and lumping wheat. He joined the Joy Makers group at Kybunga and played footy, tennis and cricket for Kybunga teams. He married Marion in 1962 and settled on the farm, keeping chooks, pigs and cows as sidelines. Their 3 daughters, Susan, Janet and Alison regularly visit the farm with their families and held the 100th Birthday Celebrations in the shearing shed at the farm.

Vic and Marion moved to Clare in 2013 and at the beginning of this year they decided living in Carinya Nursing Home in Clare was the safer option. Vic was in good spirits for his birthday celebration and very proud of his card from King Charles and Queen Camilla.

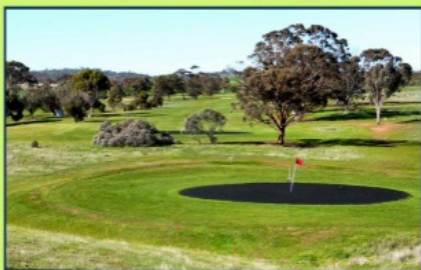

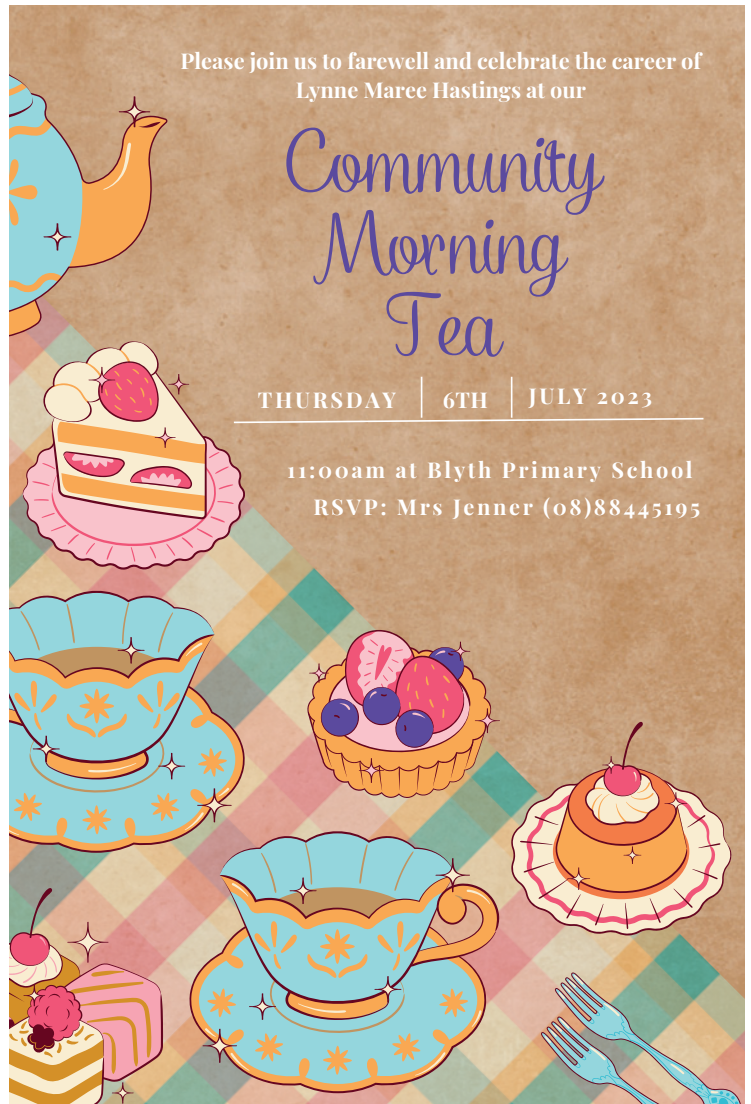

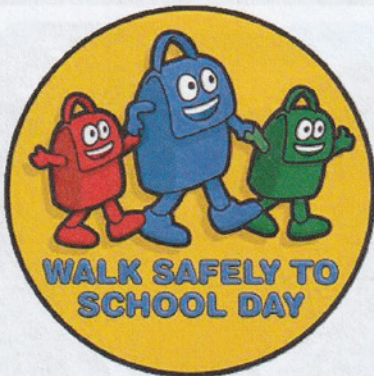




Drone on school grounds
