Ian and Angie finally got to celebrate with around 50 friends and family who enjoyed afternoon tea and wedding cake at the Blyth Town Hall.



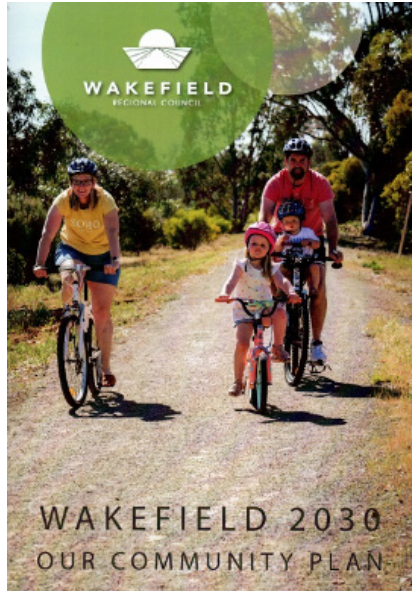

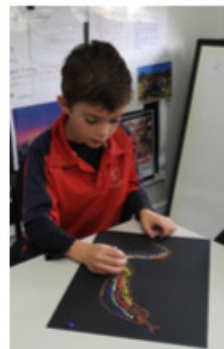
